










Wyoming State Treasurer's Office Pool Attribution - IDP Methodology Pool A vs. Target Allocation Index FYTD Ending June 30, 2022









That Council, by resolution, authorize a contract for professional services with Haass Construction, Inc., in the Amount of \$71,000.00, for construction services for security improvements for the Casper Municipal Court, 201 North David Street, Casper, Wyoming, 82601.

Summary

There have been several incidents involving City Staff in the past few months that have emphasized the need for increased security measures to ensure the safety of our Staff. City Staff has developed and a plan for improvements to Municipal Court security and have received proposals to complete the improvements.

The security improvements involve controlling access to Staff work areas and creating a secure reception area. The improvements include fortification of the door openings using frame work and ballistic panels, installation of two new partition walls with bullet resistant doors, and creation of a new Staff access to the existing secure reception area.

The City of Casper has received 3 proposals for this work with the lowest cost from Haass Construction. The improvements as proposed will cost \$71,000.00 to complete and would function as permanent security improvements for the work area.

Financial Considerations

Funding will be from Cares Act funding designated for building modifications.

Affirm: Email vote to replace Walk-in Freezer (Freezer keeps tripping, compressor needs replaced). Commissioner Charlie Moore moved to affirm the motion. Steve Cathey seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Financial Report

Nick Martinez reported the ending balance as of June 7, 2022 was \$44,577.33. Tracy Good asked about an outstanding balance from several invoices in the amount of \$2,869.58. Steve Cathey reported the invoices are scheduled to be paid this evening.

Charlie Moore moved to accept the financial statement as presented. Steve Cathey seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Building Report - Tom Popilek, Facilities Director

A. Freezer & Walk-in Cooler in Kitchen

Cooler went down. Compressor overheating due to no air circulation; 250 degree temperature flow for current incorrect placement of duct work. Recommended rerouting through rooftop exhaust fan. Approximately \$2,500, rerouting and replacing component will prolong the equipment since the system is newer. Ceiling tiles have been removed to help allow airflow and remove heat.

Charlie Moore moved to approve the installation of rooftop exhaust fan not to exceed \$3,000. Steve Cathey seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kitchen needs redundancy in case of failures for walk in coolers and freezers. Old back up units have been robbed to keep the main units running. Back up units that could be used on normal basis are being used as dry storage. Recommended getting all these units back in operation. Evaporation Condenser and Head Units need to be replaced. Walk-in Freezer approximately \$16,000, replacement of both \$32,000. More cost effective to maintain the units instead of neglecting and allowing to equipment to fail. These units are isolated; therefore the overheating air circulation will not be an issue. Lead time unknown, but most likely 12-16 weeks. JPB requested a firm cost estimate and time frame to be presented when Tom has.

B. Flooring in Kitchen (dish pit area)

Eric Nelson, County Attorney has been notified for warranty assistance for continuation warranty. Hopefully this should not be an additional cost to the JPB.

Issues with the kitchen remodel performed 2 years ago. Last summer the kitchen was remodeled again through the warranty. The same issues have returned. Water behind the FRP, water in the tract, stainless coming apart from wall, drip edge was installed wrong. Design needs to be reviewed and changed for the current needs. Same issues and concerns as before. JPB wants to force the issues and craftsmanship.

Other Business:

A. Discussion of Increasing Account Balance to \$100,000

Charlie Moore moved to sustain the balance at \$100,000. Peter Nicolaysen seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Tracy Good will invoice the County and City for the money needed to bring both accounts up to \$100,000.
